# A pioneer in donor human milk banking, Mothers' Milk Bank:

- is the largest nonprofit milk bank in North America.
- has a proven history of safety with more than 30 years of experience providing milk to hospitals and outpatients.
- has a certified ISO7 laboratory and is the first nonprofit milk bank in the country to receive this certification.
- produces six biologic milks to meet the needs of all infants.
- costs less than one-third the price of for-profit donor human milk due to low tissue processing fees.
- implements and adheres to evidence-based processes.
- partners with numerous healthcare facilities throughout the United States which operate Donation and Outreach Centers for MMB.
- is a founding member of the Human Milk Banking Association of North America (HMBANA).
- recognizes the inherent perfection of human milk with a goal to keep human milk as close to its natural state as possible while complying with the guidelines set forth by HMBANA.
- provides milk to outpatient infants.
- operates a charity care program.
